

Problems when editing a Docbook module


Because there is no schema association:

- the module is not valid
- the content completion assistant doesn't propose any elements



Manage IDs


Search and refactoring actions for ID/IDREFS operate in the scope determined by the master files.






Update XML module references when renaming or moving it

<oXygen/> automatically updates all the references to a module when the module is renamed or moved in the Project or in the Resource Hierarchy/Dependencies view.
