

Writing without contextual guidance it's like writing with pen on paper.

what element should I insert in this context?

about what I should write inside this element?

this document is huge, how do I find next section?





Contextual Guidance

What element should I insert in this context?

- in-place actions
- form controls
- contextual toolbar





Contextual Guidance

About what I should write inside this element?

- placeholders
- element's description





Contextual Guidance

This document is huge, how do I find next section?

- Outline
 - structure mode
 - contents mode





Validation

Writing without validation it's like building a tree house without a ruler.





Validation

Why Schematron validation is important?

- automatic
- validate as you type
- can define fixups with Schematron Quick Fixes





Forms

Traditional forms lack control and flexibility over.

- input
- store
- process





Forms 2.0

Submit forms with Web Author because:

- input
 - is highly customizable
- store
 - anywhere you want
- process
 - automatically through XSLT





Forms 2.0

Advantages of submitting forms with Web Author

- no need to learn addition API's
- well structured
- collaborative
- easy to process





Procedures

A series of actions conducted in a certain order or manner

- actions order is important
- actions can be assigned to a particular person





Wiki-based Procedures

No advantage over a regular whiteboard

- one can override colleague's changes
- hard to track who mark a task done
- cannot control who can mark tasks done





Well-structured Procedures

- team based editable zones
- facets show only tasks that I'm responsible for
- track each change
