- XML vocabulary
- Vale rules

<incorrect-term ignorecase="true" severity="warning">  
  <match type="regular-expression">(?:[^\s,]+,){1,} \w+ (?:and|or) \  
w+[.?!]</match>  
  <message>Use the Oxford comma in '%s'.</message>  
</incorrect-term>
```

extends: existence

message: "Use the Oxford comma in '%s'."

link: <https://docs.microsoft.com/en-us/style-guide/punctuation/commas>

scope: sentence

level: suggestion

nonword: true

tokens:

- '(?:[^\s,]+,){1,} \w+ (?:and|or) \w+[.?!]'

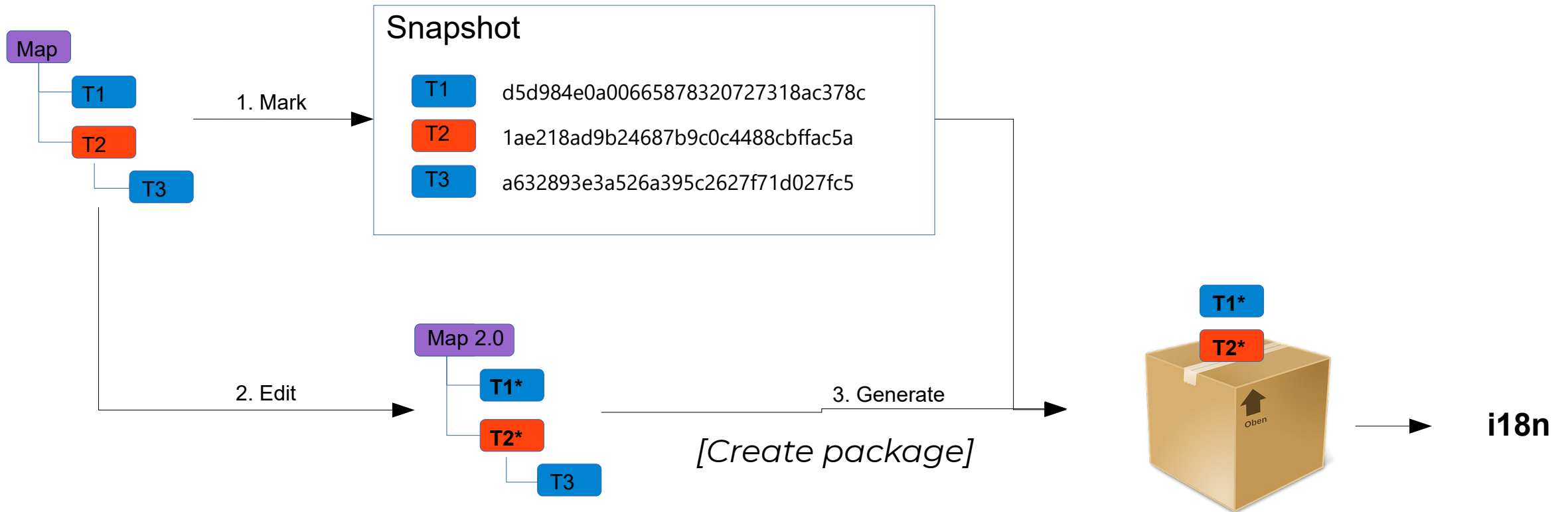

DITA Translation Package Builder

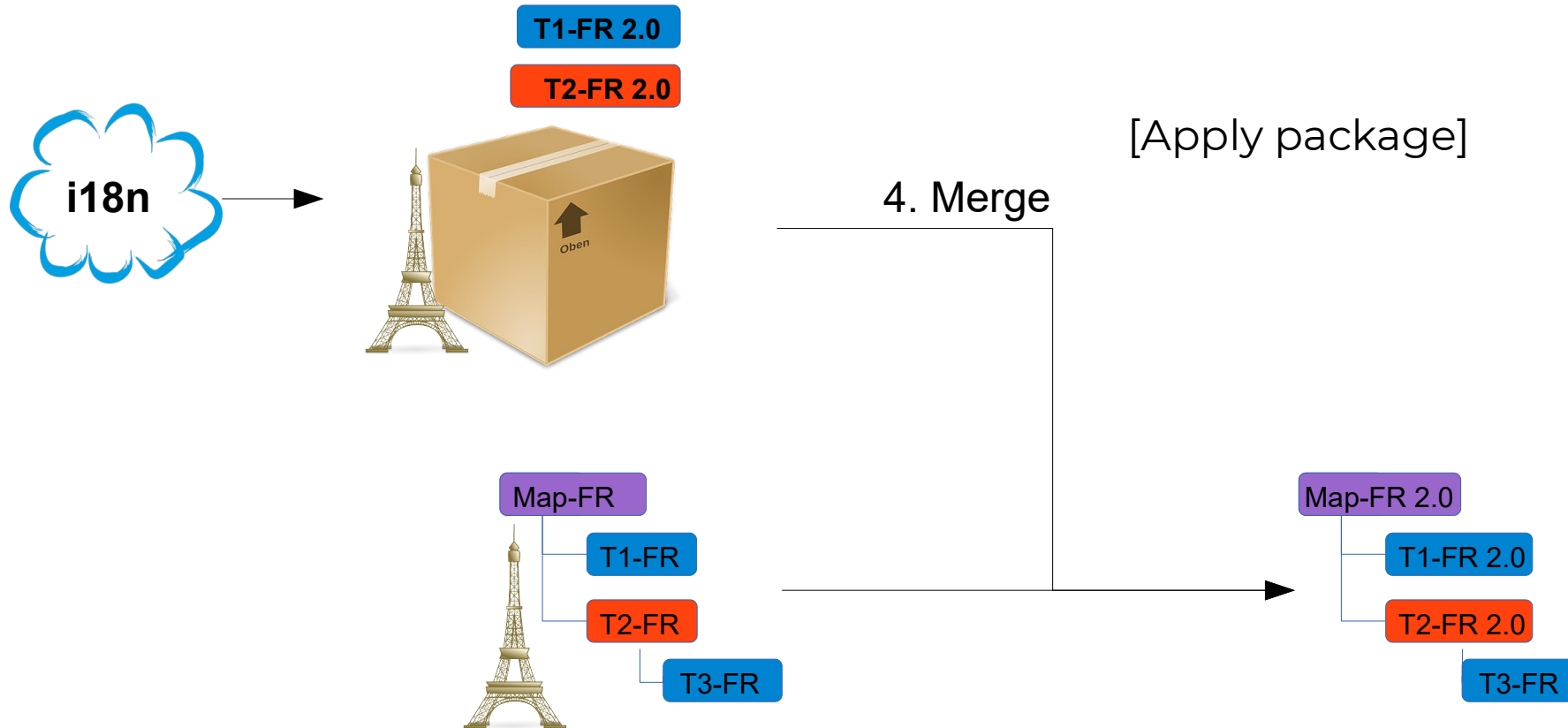
- Builds a translation package that can be sent to translators.
- Extracts the changed files back into your project once you receive the package back from the translators.
